DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use in location of infestation. Use this fogger in a manner consistent with its labeling. Cover exposed food, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioning. Put out all flames except pilot lights. Keep children and pets away from fogger. Close doors and windows. Use one fogger for each 600 cubic feet of unobstructed space. 2000 cubic feet when using a 12 oz. can. Additional foggers should be used for areas where mist might not flow. Increase fogging time is needed for these same areas. Place can in the middle of the room on a stand or table on the floor. Place several layers of newspaper underneath to prevent misting on surface. Push down on the fogger lock at the base. Keep all arms and legs when actuating. Point top of fogger away from face and eyes. Set can down on prepared surface and leave the area immediately. Keep unobstructed for at least 8 hours. Open doors and windows and ventilate thoroughly for 30 minutes. Airplane and some plastics may be affected by this product. Place newspapers on surfaces before treatment and cover plastic items such as plastic furniture, stored boxes, eye glasses, etc.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

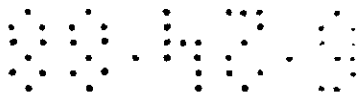
