A review of your submission follows:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. The statement Active Ingredient should be singular.
  - b. Delete the percentage, "3.96%" following words Active Ingredient in the ingredient statement. It is misleading.
  - c. Label should bear a statement, preferably below the ingredient statement, "Contains sodium nitrite."

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.


2. Your Confidential statement of Formula is unacceptable. Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula with the following corrections.
  - a. Declare the full trade name of the nonylphenol polyethoxylate e.g., Carsanox M-9 from Lonza, Inc.

- b. Declare the trade name of the EDTA in your formulation. It must be a 38% active EDTA or calculation corrections may be required.
3. It has been noted that you will submit the requested efficacy data within one year as outlined in our letter dat. 3 February 11, 1985 (item #3).

**Precautionary Statements  
Hazardous to Humans and Domestic Animals**

**DANGER**

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

**Corrosive.** Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN.** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

- Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal
- Do not store on side
- Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL**

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray or mixture of rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DISINFECTS**

DC-6 is recommended for pre-cleaned, hard, non-porous, inanimate surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. To disinfect, apply with a mop, cloth or sponge to pre-cleaned surfaces and allow to remain wet for 10 minutes.

**FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING**

When disinfecting cleaned, hard, non-porous, inanimate surfaces suspected of being contaminated, apply a disinfecting solution of 1½ oz. per gallon of water very liberally, allowing a contact time of at least 10 minutes or more. Remove soiled solution and follow with second application.

**REST ROOMS -- LOCKERS ROOMS -- SHOWERS**

Wash all soiled areas with a disinfecting solution of 1½ oz. or more of DC-6 per gallon of water. Do not rinse.

**FLOORS -- WALLS -- WOODWORK**

Normal or slightly soiled areas -- daily cleaning with a disinfecting solution of 1½ oz. DC-6 per gallon of water helps to control cross contamination on hard, inanimate surfaces. Do not rinse.

For heavily soiled areas, follow with second application using fresh DC-6 solution of the same concentration

**HOSPITALS**

DC-6 is excellent for helping to maintain a sanitary condition in Hospitals, Rest Homes, Sanitariums and other institutions. In all cases, follow the recommendations listed.

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
