DIRECTIONS

SOILED SURFACES — FLOORS and WALLS — Use 4 ounces per gallon of water as a disinfecting cleaner. At a disinfecting rinse, use 2 ounces per gallon of water.

TOILETS ---- URINALS ---- Use 4 ounces to the gallon of water; usually sufficient for disinfecting and deodorizing urinals, exterior bowl surfaces, toilet seats, and other fixtures which should be thoroughly cleaned every day.

GENERAL PREMISE DISINFECTING ----After removing dirt, wash or spray counters, chairs, tables, beds, garbage cans, waste baskets with at least one part of Pine Oil Disinfectant to 80 parts of water.
