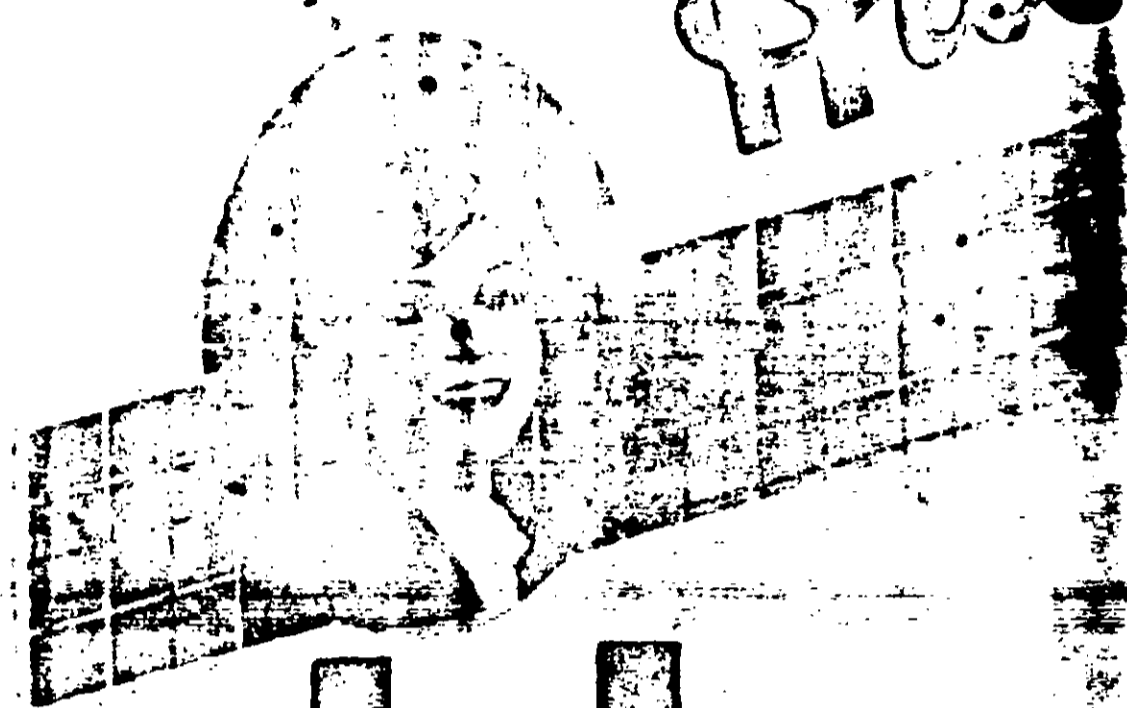

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS: SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE 5.25% INERT INGREDIENTS 94.75%

for Nylon - Rayon - Acrylic - Polyester - Cotton

DIRECTIONS

USE FOR WHITE AND FAST COLORS ONLY

IN THE LAUNDRY: Add $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of bleach per each 2 gallons of water. Boiling is unnecessary. Mix well. Wash in usual way. As a bleach add $\frac{1}{8}$ cup or 1 oz. per 2 gallons water or one cup bleach per each washing machine load (16

DIRECTIONS

FOR USE ON WALLS - FLOORS - TUBS - SINKS

BATHROOM & KITCHEN: For drain pipes, bath tubs, and toilet bowls, use full strength. Do not let stand or use with other household chemicals. We recommend one part of bleach to 20 parts of water or $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of bleach per quart of cold

DIRECTIONS

IN THE LAUNDRY: Add 1/2 cup of bleach per each 2 gallons of water. Boiling is unnecessary. Mix well. Wash in usual way. As a bleach add 1/8 cup or 1 oz. per 2 gallons water or one cup bleach per each washing machine load (16 gallon machine). Rinse in several waters before drying. In automatics bleach should be added to suds water before clothing is placed in machine. If added while clothing is in suds, dilute with 1 quart of water before adding.

STAIN REMOVAL: To remove scorch, ink, fruit, tea, coffee, grass, or other stains, add 1/4 cup of bleach to quart of water. Mix well and allow to soak until stains disappear. Rinse thoroughly.

CAUTION - BLEACH

Undiluted bleach will irritate skin or eyes. Rinse immediately. If accidentally taken internally, feed cooked cereal followed by salad oil. Call doctor. Harmful if swallowed.

SEE BACK PANEL FOR OTHER WARNINGS

FOR DRAIN PIPES, BATH TUBS, AND TOILET BOWLS: Use full strength. Do not let stand or use with other household chemicals. We recommend one part of bleach to 20 parts of water or 1/4 cup of bleach per quart of cold or lukewarm water for cleaning refrigerators. Clean garbage cans and pans with bleach (undiluted), then rinse with clean water.

FOR ALL SURFACES IN KITCHEN AND BATHROOM: Use 1/2 cup of bleach per 2 gallons of water. Wash thoroughly with warm water. Spread the solution with a cloth - let stand for 2 minutes and then rinse well.

DO NOT USE IN COPPER, ALUMINUM, OR BRASS.
 Use in porcelain or enamel-lined tubs.
