Dear Ms. Gaudette:

The following amendments, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, are acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- Revise First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001-1
- Amend label with transferred use claims (from previously approved product literature) ·
- Removal of establishment number: 1757-NJ-2

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

Revise the Precautionary Statements to read: 1.

fumes or vapor. Chemical worker's goggles must be worn when handling. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

2. Revise the First Aid Statements by including the following section:

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is **not** breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if **possible**. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

- 3. Revise the "If Swallowed" section of the First Aid Statements by including the statement "Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person." at the end of this section.
- 4. Revise the First Aid Statements by including the statement "Have the product container or label with you when call a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment."
- 5. Remove the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal." from the "Storage" section and place it directly following the heading "Storage and Disposal."
- 6. Revise the heading "Storage" to read "Pesticide Storage."
- 7. Revise the heading "Disposal" to read "Pesticide Disposal."
- 8. Include the heading "Container Disposal" directly preceding the statement "Triple rinse (or equivalent)...If burned, stay out of smoke."
- 9. The ingredient statement must total 100%.

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three(3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.
