The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Delete the words "GENERAL CLASSIFICATION."
 - b. Revise the "Environmental Hazards" section of the label to read as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife.
Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public waters unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in an NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.



It is extremely effective in reducing spoilage in adhesives formulated with animal, protein, vegetable, polyvinyl acetate, polyvinyl alcohol and styrene-butadiene ingredients.

AMERSTAT®252 can also be incorporated into aqueous mineral slurries, such as clay, calcium carbonate and titanium dioxide to reduce bacterial and fungal contamination and thus maintain product integrity.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Refer to the AMERSTAT® 252 microbiocide Product Data Sheet for use directions and other technical information.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Avoid extreme heat or freezing. Store in ventilated area.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
