PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
Hazards to Human & Domestic Animals

DANGER

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses) protective clothing and protective gloves. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

- 2. According to PR Notice 83-3 all products are required to have appropriate Storage and Disposal directions. It appears that this product is distributed in 30 and 55 gallon drums: 100 and 200 liter drums. Revise the Storage and Disposal instructions as follows:

**Storage and Disposal**

Do not contaminate water food, or feed by storage or disposal

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Keep container closed when not in use. Do not drop, roll or skid drum. Store in a dry location protected from freezing or excessive heat. Do not reuse empty container.
