LOCKER ROOM DISINFECTION

To guard against the spread of athlete's foot fungi use one ounce of Microcide SPA to one gallon of water for disinfecting shower room floors, locker room benches, bath mats, runways, and other surfaces commonly contacted by bare feet.

Clean floors and runways with a suitable detergent before disinfecting with the above described solution of Microcide SPA.

Microcide SPA may be used to disinfect bathing suits, and shower caps. After washing immerse the suits and caps for ten minutes, in a solution containing one ounce of Microcide SPA per gallon of water. Wring and hang to dry.



DIRECTIONS

Swimming Pool Algaecide

The presence of algae in outdoor swimming pools is objectionable because of the color, cloudiness, odor and increased chlorine demand of the water. The use of Microcide SPA will help to maintain the water in a clean sanitary condition.

1. If algae growth is observed, add one gallon Microcide SPA for each 10,000 gallons of water to control growth of many algae species.

When growth has ceased and existing algae have withered, clean the pool, draining and refilling if necessary, then add one gallon Microcide SPA per 25,000 gallons of water.

Subsequent treatment for proper algae control should be made every five to seven days at the rate of one gallon of SPA per 50,000 gallons of water.

2. When no algae growth is visible, the initial treatment should be made at the ratio of one gallon of SPA to 25,000 gallons of Subsequent treatments should then water. be made every five to seven days, using one gallon of SPA to each 50,000 gallons of water.

The correct level of active ingredients in the pool is between two and five parts per million. See your serviceman for a test kit. SPA is compatible with the usual water treatment chemicals. By using SPA for control of algae growth the chlorine demand of the pool may be significantly reduced.
