The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
  - a. Delete "Sodium Carbonate" and "Tetrasodium ethylenediamine tetraacetate" from the active ingredients. They are now considered inert ingredients. Adjust your inert percentage accordingly.
  - b. Delete the word "milk."
  - c. Change the "Directions" heading to "Directions For Use."
  - d. Delete the word "Sanitizer" from the center panel.
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.



## DSC DIRECTIONS

DSC is a powerful disinfectant and germicide. It is effective against all known bacteria, viruses, fungi, and spores.

**LIGHT SOILED AREAS** — Dilute DSC 1:10 with water. Apply to surface and allow to stand for 10 minutes. Rinse with water.

**HEAVY SOILED AREAS** — Dilute DSC 1:5 with water. Apply to surface and allow to stand for 15 minutes. Rinse with water. For stubborn stains, use DSC undiluted. Allow to stand for 30 minutes. Rinse with water.

**DO NOT MIX WITH SOAP OR ANIONIC DETERGENTS**

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards To Humans And Domestic Animals

#### DANGER

Keep Out Of Reach Of Children. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing thoroughly. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

#### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
