DIRECTIONS

FOR DUSTING: apply thoroughly, early and regularly; make certain to apply dust to lower as well as upper surfaces of plant foliage; make certain to dust early in the season upon the first appearance of the insects and thereafter about every two weeks depending upon the severity of the infestation. It is always advisable to dust when the plants have moisture on them, preferably after a rain.

FOR WET SPRAYING

LUCKY STRIKE ROSE DUST can be used for wet spraying as well as any dusting, for wet spraying, we recommend the mixing of one to two pounds of dust to about ten gallons of water or approximately five to ten tablespoonsful to each gallon of water. Quantity to be used may vary according to infestation and hardiness of insects. Always add the powder to the water and mix thoroughly, and keep material agitated while spraying.






