

This product should be applied as a coarse (large droplet) spray in spot treatment of localized surface areas only.

Cockroaches, Ants, Silverfish, Spiders, Crickets, and Earwigs: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners, under sills and closets, cracks, and crevices, along baseboards and door sills and frames, behind and beneath stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets, and around garbage plumbing and other utility installations. Pets driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. Spray ant trails, and points of entry.

Flies, Mosquitoes, and Ticks: Apply thoroughly as a mist treatment to infested areas. Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray pet beds and resting quarters nearby cracks and crevices, and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding. Treatment of pet areas. Additionally, treat pets with an E.P.A. approved product registered for pet use. Do not spray pets with this product.

Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of windows and door frames and other areas where these pests may be entering the home. Also spray dark corners and localized areas, such as under eaves, porches, partitions, and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.
