DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

HOW TO MIX AND APPLY For lawns and vegetable areas to be sprayed, for all other applications, apply as a thorough cover spray. Mix applications when insects first appear or in absence of an expected infestation. Thorough application is needed as a seed in directions. Use a clean sprayer and carefully measure. Dilute with water. Use a coarse spray. Do not spray on lawns, soil and other surface applications. Use a medium fine mist. Do not spray on plants with dew or rain after use.

ROSES & FLOWERS: Roses, Azaleas, Cypripediums	Aphids, Mites, Leafhoppers, Thrips	8 lbs (4 fl oz) in 3 gals of water covers 125 sq ft. 32 oz 24 gal of water covers 1,000 sq ft.	In the north, if CHINCH BUGS are the only insect problem, a lower rate of 4 lbs in 3 gals of water covers 250 sq ft.
TREES & SHRUBS: Oak, Maple, Linum, Holly, Boxwood, Pine	Aphids, Mites, Scale Crawlers, Leaf Miners, Bagworms	4 lbs (2 fl oz) in 3 gals of water covers 125 sq ft. 32 oz 24 gal of water covers 1,000 sq ft.	Spray underside of leaves. Wet plants to the dripping point. Try to penetrate dense foliage.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED—Call physician immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken orally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If it is necessary to induce vomiting, give victim one or two glasses of water and insert finger in back of throat. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear.
