National Chemsearch EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner is recommended for the cleaning, sanitizing, deodorizing and disinfecting of floors, walls, sinks, pipes, telephones, toilet chairs, bidets, fixtures and other environmental surfaces. It is also used for cleaning plants, meat packaging, dairy plants, and other food processing equipment.

EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner is time saving and leaves no residue. It is effective against a wide spectrum of Gram positive and Gram negative bacteria, including Pseudomonas aeruginosa at a concentration of 200 ppm. EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner is also effective against the following viruses: Poliovirus, Adenovirus type 2, Coxsackievirus B₁, Herpes simplex, Influenza A, and Vaccinia virus.

DISINFECTION: At a concentration of 200 ppm, EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner is effective against the following bacteria: *Escherichia coli*, *Salmonella typhimurium*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Shigella flexneri*, and *Yersinia enterocolitica*.

At this level, the product is also fungicidal against the pathogenic fungi *Trichophyton mentagrophytes* and *Microsporum canis*.

The product when used on environmental animal surfaces at 200 ppm per gallon of water exhibits effective virucidal activity against Influenza A virus (representative of the common influenza), Herpes simplex (causative agent of fever blisters and mononucleosis), Adenovirus type 2 (causative agent of upper respiratory infection), and Vaccinia virus (representative of the pox virus group).

Efficiency tests have demonstrated that EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner is an effective bactericide, fungicide and virucide in the presence of organic soil (5% blood serum).

Mold and Mildew: EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner prevents and controls mold and mildew and the odors they cause on hard nonporous non-metallic surfaces.

Sanitization: When used for sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment and contact items, limit active ingredients to 200 ppm. At this level, NO PORTABLE WATER RANGE is required. EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner is an effective sanitizer when used in water up to 250 ppm hardness (CaCO₃).

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

This is a classification of Federal Law. Use this product in accordance with its labeling.

EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner has been found to be highly effective against mold and mildew on hard non-metallic surfaces. It is also effective against bacteria and viruses on hard non-metallic surfaces. It is also effective against fungi on hard non-metallic surfaces.

DISINFECTION: For disinfection of environmental surfaces, use a concentration of 200 ppm. For disinfection of food equipment and contact items, use a concentration of 200 ppm. For sanitization of previously cleaned food equipment and contact items, use a concentration of 200 ppm. For mold and mildew control, use a concentration of 200 ppm.

Ingestion: If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing mechanically or mechanically may be needed. If persistent convulsions may be controlled by the cautious intravenous injection of a short-acting barbiturate drug.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticides that cannot be reused or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place.
