

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**  
**INSTRUCTIONS:**  
 Use for flies, mosquitoes, ticks, roaches, crickets, beetles, fleas.

To operate: Hold dispenser upright. Push valve opening spray from tank. Push button to release spray. Hold for 1-2 seconds being sprayed. Use nozzle — 6 to 8 inches for normal use (100% coverage).

For best results, use during the morning for the most effective results. Do not use in bedrooms and nurseries. Do not use in areas where food is prepared, stored, or consumed. Do not use in areas where food is stored, prepared, or consumed.

Caution: Do not spray directly into face and avoid breathing the mist. Repeat spraying as needed.

Do not spray on plants, especially roses and geraniums. Spray curtains, beds and bedding; mattress, upholstery and spray drapes. Repeat spraying as needed.

Clothes Mites — remove clothes from closets, brush and air well. Spray clothes, trunk drawers and close. Spray 30 days, 3-4 times each week as directed.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Delete the statement "Atropine sulfate is antidotal" and the statement "Note to Physician: Atropine sulfate is antidotal."
  - b. Add to the label the statement "Remove pets, birds and cover or remove fish aquariums before using."
  - c. Refer to PR Notice 83-3. Proper storage and disposal statements must be placed on the label.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
