PYRA-FOG 100 is formulated to control roaches, silverfish, weevils infesting stored food products, bedbugs, flies and certain other insects in their accessible stages. For best results, PYRA-FOG 100 should be used with electric sprayers, but hand or compressed air sprayers may be used.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Do not breathe spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

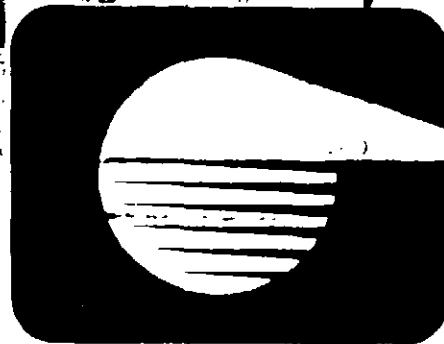

Good housekeeping makes for more effective insect control and a definite savings in the amount of PYRA-FOG 100 required. To spray food storage areas, remove food products from shelves, racks or storage areas. Spray these areas

thoroughly with PYRA-FOG 100 and packaged food, spray in such a manner upon the packages. For food products between and around sacks, paying cracks, crevices, walls and any other to the weevils.
