

ANNUAL WEEDS: Apply 1 gallon of CENTEX (diluted with up to 10 gallons of water) per 150 to 200 square feet when plants are young. Thoroughly wet with a sprayer or sprinkling can all parts of the plant, particularly the growing tips.

PERENNIAL WEEDS: For best results, treat plants during their dormant stage or when nearing maturity. Apply by spraying 4 to 2 diaganlons of CENTEX per 100 square feet. For deep-rooted weeds and diagrass such as Bermuda, Johnson, Bindweed and Quack grass, the devier rate is recommended. Retreatment may be necessary to secure adequate control of certain hard-to-kill weeds.

NOTE: This material is nonselective and affects all types of

vegetation. Extreme care should be exercised in its use to prevent killing lawns, shrubs, trees and other valuable plants. This includes the treatment of areas which may be underlaid by tree roots.
