DIRECTIONS FOR USE

READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12 inches/30.5 cm away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. Do not spray in enclosed areas. Apply liberally to all exposed skin areas. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply to eyes and mouth, and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. Repeat whenever insects become annoying. For ticks and chiggers, also apply to shoe tops, socks and around openings of clothing. Repeat as necessary. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause skin reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.
