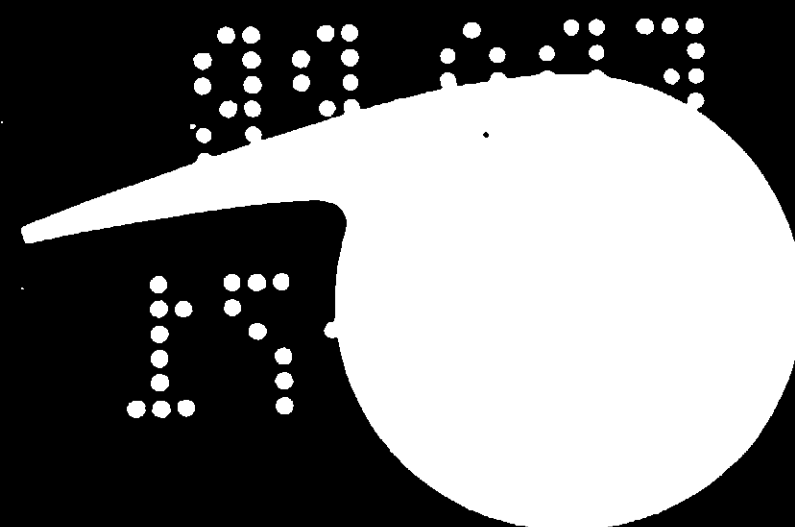

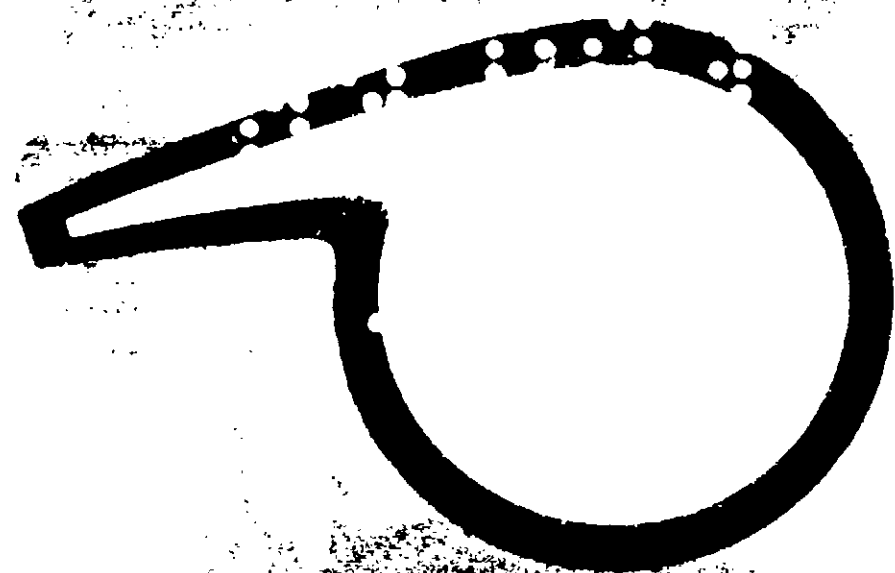

DIRECTIONS:

For Dusk, Morning Glory, in place
rows and rows of 1 gallon to 100
gallons of water. I want 1 acre. Wet plants
thoroughly and repeat when necessary.

For woody plants such as Poison Oak, Brambles, Poison Ivy, Sumac, Honeysuckle — Mix 8 ounces per gallon of water and drench thoroughly while plants are in full leaf. Repeat application in four weeks if necessary.

To Kill Stumps — Mix 1 pint in one quart of Kerosene or Diesel Oil. Spray all of the stump area thoroughly.
