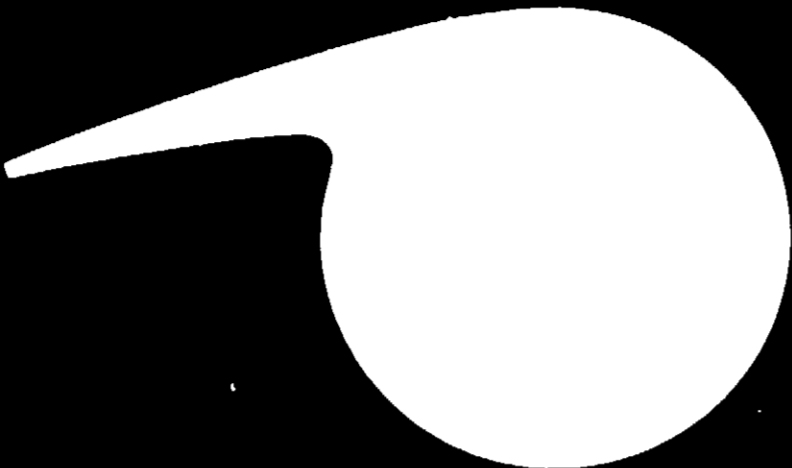


DIRECTIONS: — For established turf fairways, etc. apply 1½ fluid ounces of National Chemsearch Chemweed 265 mixed with 2 gallons of water per 1000 square feet, or ½ gallon mixed with 30-40 gallons of water per acre. For spot treatment mix at the above proportions and use sprinkling can or power sprayer. For larger areas a Boom sprayer is recommended. For maximum results the area should not be cut for 2-3 days before or after spraying. Do not sprinkle or water for 24 hours after application. Full visible effects requires about three weeks.

CAUTION: — Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Harmful if swallowed. After use wash hands and other parts of the body that is contaminated with the Concentrate spray or washings. Store tightly closed containers away from green houses, seed, plants, fertilizers and water supplies. Keep from freezing. Do not spray flower beds, borders or shrubbery. Avoid allowing spray to drift over flowering plants, shrubs, etc. Do not use first mowing as a mulch. After use, rinse equipment, including nozzles with water to which has been added a wetting agent or detergent. Pools, streams and water sources must not be contaminated with the concentrate or spray washings.
