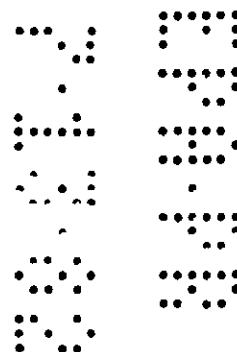

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FLIES AND MOSQUITOES: The surface deposit of a mixture of 1 gallon of VINA-CHLOR with 10 gallons of water or fuel oil will aid in the control of flies and mosquitoes. Thoroughly wet the surfaces where flies breed or alight, such as garbage dumps, refuse heaps, outside of barns and buildings. For mosquitoes, spray undergrowth near stagnant water, low damp areas and refuse dumps where water is trapped in tin cans, discarded tires and other things of this type. Repeat when necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing mist. In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush with plenty of water; for eyes get medical attention. Do not apply or allow to drift to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals.

Wash with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking; wear clean clothing. Store away from children or domestic animals. If swallowed, get prompt medical attention. Avoid contact with skin.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.

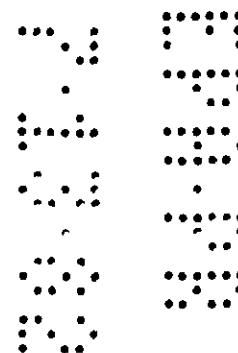

Your Application Dated July 6, 1982

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under Section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Please refer to the enclosed type size guide for assistance in selecting the correct print size for the front panel signal word, child hazard warning, the heading "Storage and Disposal," and the center panel uses group limitation "NOT FOR RESALE, etc."
2. Based upon more recent medical evaluation, we recommend the following revisions to the Statement of Practical Treatment:

- a. Revise the "if swallowed" advice to read:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING unless other treatment is not available. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

- b. beneath the Statement of Practical Treatment add the following:

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN - Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

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- c. Delete "for at least 15 minutes" from the "if in eyes" advice since this long a wash period is excessive.
3. It is noted that the additional storage information about separation and thickening and required warming and stirring does not appear on the submitted typewritten label. Has the product chemistry been altered so that this advice is no longer pertinent?
