- Add "...if inhaled or absorbed through the skin" to "Harmful if Swallowed" in the precautionary statements.
- 4. Also in this section you may delete "In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water" as it is duplicative of statements in the statement of practical treatment.
- 5. Nove the statement of practical treatment section so it appears immediately before the Note to Physician. Also move the statement "Get medical attention if irritation persists" so it appears as the second sentence under "If on skin."
- 6. In the environmental hesards section, revise the first sentence to read "This product is toxic to fish, birds and wildlife."
- Provide the flash point for this product. Depending on the flash point, the text of the physical or chemical basards section may need revision.
