Subject: Amendment - General Label Update
EPA Registration No. 1769-137
Your Application Dated September 21, 1984

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The ingredients do not add up to 100%. It appears the methoxychlor declaration is incorrect and should read 7.50%. Make this revision.
2. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN should appear above the signal word CAUTION on the left panel.
3. Add "...if inhaled or absorbed through the skin" to "Harmful if Swallowed" in the precautionary statements.
4. Also in this section you may delete "In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water" as it is duplicative of statements in the statement of practical treatment.
5. Move the statement of practical treatment section so it appears immediately before the Note to Physician. Also move the statement "Get medical attention if irritation persists" so it appears as the second sentence under "If on skin."
6. In the environmental hazards section, revise the first sentence to read "This product is toxic to fish, birds and wildlife."
7. Provide the flash point for this product. Depending on the flash point, the text of the physical or chemical hazards section may need revision.
