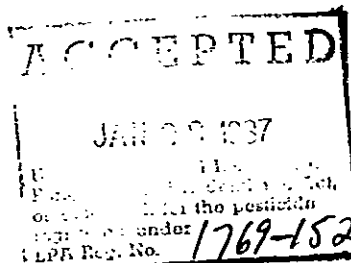

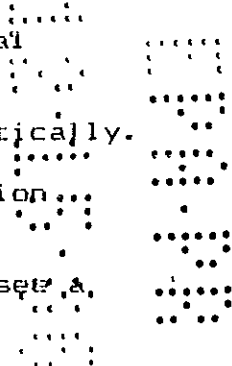
**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Aids in reduction of airborne bacteria. Remove protective cap. Hold dispenser upright, pointing valve away from face.
