TURF-EDGE is highly effective for use as a contact spray for control of weeds and grasses and for killing undesirable woody plants.

DIRECTIONS

CHEMICAL EDGING: Mix 1 gallon of TURF-EDGE with 1 gallon of water. Apply only to the leaves and stems of undesirable plants to be destroyed. Careful application of TURF-EDGE destroys undesirable vegetation growing under shrubs and trees. Only the vegetation sprayed will be affected. TURF-EDGE is a contact type treatment with little residual activity. Treatment should be repeated when necessary.

DRIVEWAYS, FENCE ROWS, TENNIS COURTS, INDUSTRIAL SITES: TURF-EDGE is an effective contact spray for control of woody perennials such as poison oak, poison sumac and poison ivy, perennials such as leafy spurge, bitter dock, goldenrod, milkweed, blueweed and perennial ragweed; annuals such as crabgrass, broomweed, chickweed, cocklebur, Jimson weed, lamb's-quarters, larkspur, prickly lettuce, ragweed and shepherd's purse

Apply TURF-EDGE to the specified plants at the concentration of 1 gallon diluted with 1 gallon of water. Thoroughly wet foliage and stems of undesirable vegetation. The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with weed species, rainfall, temperature and other conditions. Repeat application when necessary.

RIGHTS-OF-WAY, ROADSIDES, DRAINAGE DITCHES: Highly effective for killing most woody plants including hardwood and coniferous species such as alder, ash, birch, cedar, elm, gum, hickory, maple, oak, pine and willow. Application may be made as a foliage spray.

Foliage spray application may be made anytime after brush has reached full leaf state and until foliage begins to discolor, preferably during periods of high temperature and humidity. Dilute TURF-EDGE with equal parts of water. Apply as a full coverage spray to foliage, stems, limbs and base of brush. Thorough coverage is essential for the best results. In roadside application on tall, dense brush, it is often necessary to spray from both sides to get proper coverage. Keep spray or drift away from crops.

CAUTION: Avoid contact of skin with strong solution of this material. In case of contact wash thoroughly with water.

NOTE: TURF-EDGE is a nonselective plant killer. Do not flush equipment on desirable plants or vegetation. Do not flush or drain equipment near domestic water supply. To minimize corrosion to equipment, wash thoroughly with water at the end of the day. Temporary nonproductivity of the soil may be caused by heavy applications; this condition usually disappears during the winter period.

DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER. WASH THOROUGHLY WITH WATER AND DETERGENT. DISCARD IN A SAFE PLACE.
