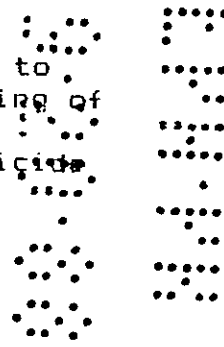
HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

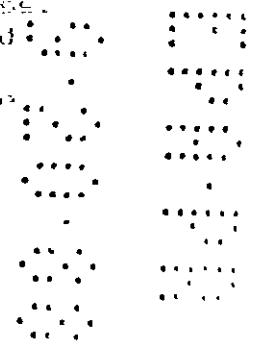

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control annual weeds and grasses such as foxtail, ryegrass, wild oat, crabgrass, cheat grass, ragweed, lambsquarters and turkey mullein, dilute one gallon of National Chemsearch HINOCIL 111 to 9 gallons of water and apply 5 gallons of the diluted spray per 1000 square feet.



For the following perennials such as smooth broome, Canada bluegrass, purpletop, quackgrass, broomsedge, aster dandelion, dog fennel, goldenrod, plantain and wild carrot, dilute one gallon of National Chemsearch FENOICIL III to 9 gallons of water and apply 10 gallon of the diluted spray per 1000 square feet.

For harder to kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Johnson grass, salt grass, bouncing bet, bracken fern, horsetail dilute 1 1/2 to 2 gallons of National Chemsearch FENOICIL III to 15 gallons of water and apply to 1000 square feet.

NOTE: Do not let the liquid come in contact with susceptible plants such as vegetables, flowers, fruit trees, ornamentals, cotton, grapes or other desirable plants or allow spray mist to drift onto these plants. (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift). Thoroughly clean spray equipment before using for other purposes. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes. Do not apply to areas underlaid by roots of desirable trees and shrubs.
