IF ON SKIN: Wipe off the acid gently. Immediately flood the surface with water, using soap freely; then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.

IF IN EYES: Wash with water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

NOTE: Do not allow to splash on chrome or nickel fixtures, enamel-coated metal or any surfaces or plated fixtures that are not guaranteed resistant to acid attack.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep securely closed away from heat or open flame in a well-ventilated area away from food and feed. The fumes are corrosive to metal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide or rinsate is a violation of federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your state pesticide or environmental control agency, or hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

FOR DISINFECTING TOILET BOWLS -- Do not remove water from bowl. Pour 3 ounces SCOOT Foamy Bowl Cleaner on the inside of bowl. Spread evenly over the entire surface covering the outer bowl rim and seat and around the water outlets. To remove heavy incrustations, scrub with a brush or scrape off. Leave on the surface for 10 minutes and flush or rinse off. Wipe the outer rim and seat with a damp cloth or sponge.

FOR CLEANING TOILET TANKS -- Tank should be cleaned as needed by pouring 3 to 4 ounces into the tank, agitating with a mop and rinsing.

FOR DISINFECTING URINALS -- Pour on the urinal wall and spread over the entire surface with a mop. Allow to remain on the surface for 10 minutes and rinse. To deodorize the drain, remove the drain trap screen, pour in 1 ounce of SCOOT Foamy Bowl Cleaner and swab the inside of the pipe. Replace the screen and flush urinal.
