

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
INDOOR APPLICATION:
 Ants, cockroaches, crickets, scorpions, spiders, saw toothed grain beetles (exposed stage), silverfish, waterbugs: Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Do not treat foodstuff or house plants. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until the surfaces are completely dry. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray sleeping quarters of pets around baseboards, window frames and door frames, wall cracks, and local area of floor. Repeat as necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not treat animals.

How to Use: Unlike most pressurized bombs, National Chemsearch Kilzone emits a small direct spray with a distance of 6 feet. Crickets, earwigs, and hard-to-reach locations can be easily treated without bending, crawling, or climbing. Treat the surface until wet, moving the spray stream steadily to prevent excessive settling and waste of material. Do not aim the spray toward people, plants, or animals.
