The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. The pesticide disposal text should be revised to read:

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

- 2. Revise the note the physician as indicated below and also move it so it appears at the end of the statements of practical treatment.

Note to Physician - Solvent presents aspiration hazard.
Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-Pan is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

- 3. You may delete the front panel fire hazard precaution since it is repeated elsewhere on the label.
- 4. Delete "new" from the center panel text since there has been no recent formulation change which would warrant such a claim.

5. Revise the hazards to humans statements to read:

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of areas being sprayed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Causes eye and skin irritation. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Avoid contamination of food, utensils, and food preparation areas.

6. The front panel child hazard precaution should appear just above the signal word, not below it.

7. In the environmental hazards revise the first two sentences to read:

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of any body of water.

8. Add back to the user restriction "Not For Resale." The Agency approved such text in a November 20, 1981 letter from Douglas Campt for your firm's use.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

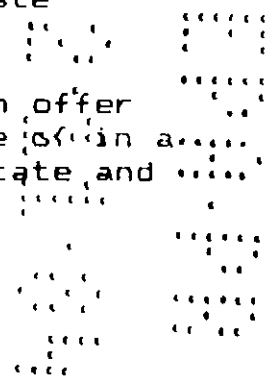

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

INDOOR APPLICATION: For Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Waterbugs: Mix 1 part of DI-SECT to 3 parts of water. Spray this mixture into cracks, crevices, around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS-Places other than private residences in which food is held, processed, prepared or served. **FOOD AREAS-APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT**

ONLY-Including areas for receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Service areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation also would be considered a food area).

Mix 1 part of DI-SECT with 3 parts of water. Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using equipment capable of delivering a pin stream of insecticide in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, where cockroaches, silverfish and waterbugs hide. Do not use this product in conduits, motor housings and electrical switch boxes.

RESTRICTIONS: Do Not Apply to rugs, carpets, draperies, wallpaper or similar materials that may be stained. Do Not Use as a space spray. Do not allow children in treated areas until surfaces are dry.

Brown Dog Ticks: Mix 1 part DI-SECT to 3 parts of water. Spray sleeping quarters of pets around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floor. Repeat when necessary. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not treat animals with this product.

OUTDOOR APPLICATION: Houseflies: Mix 1 part DI-SECT to 3 parts of water. For fly control apply with a coarse spray to runoff. Thoroughly treat breeding areas, paying particular attention to surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, garbage cans, and patios where flies are a pest or enter.

General Use as a classification is no longer deemed valid by the Agency, even when products are not subject to restricted use as in the case of the subject product. If a product is classified for restricted use, this classification notifies individuals that the chemical may be applied only by or under the direct supervision of a certified applicator.
