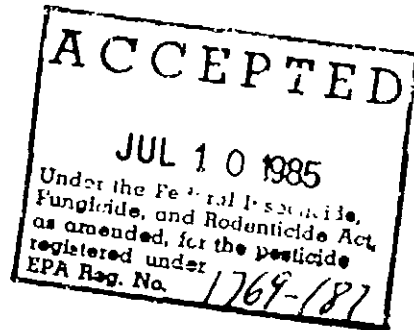

**CAUTION**

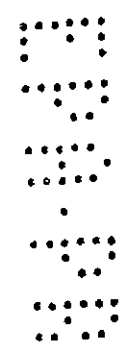

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.



IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

**As an Air Sanitizer:** For reduction of airborne bacteria. Close all windows and doors. Spray FLAIR so that light fog forms. FLAIR will reduce the number of airborne bacteria and virus particles. This treatment temporarily sanitizes the air. Repeated applications should be made periodically according to conditions that prevail.

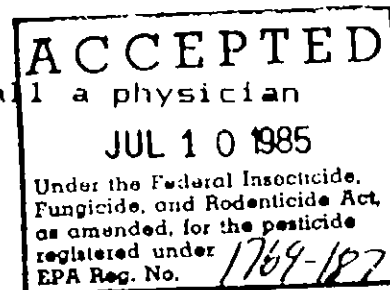
**For Deodorizing:** As an air deodorizer, spray FLAIR upwards into the atmosphere, using a good sprayer that will produce aerosol size particles. To deodorize surfaces - for control of foul or dank odors, spray directly on the surfaces to be treated after they have been cleaned. Dampen a cloth with this liquid and use for wiping bathroom fixtures, telephones, door knobs, etc., for excellent deodorizing results.

**AREAS OF USE:** When used as directed, may be used in hotels, motels, hospitals, restaurants, apartments, office buildings, nursing homes and other areas where air sanitization is indicated.
