DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is in violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SPACE SPRAY - To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths: Shake container gently to be sure contents are uniformly mixed. Close doors and windows and turn off ventilative equipment. Pour in sprayer and mist all parts of the room or area at a dosage of 1 fluid ounce of AQUA-FOG per 1000 cubic feet of space. Repeat as needed. Use as a space spray in food processing plants only when the plants are not in operation. Do not remain in the treated area. Ventilate the area when treatment is completed.

CONTACT SPRAY: To Kill Roaches, Waterbugs and Silverfish: Shake container gently as above. Direct spray in such a manner as to penetrate all cracks, crevices and other hiding places. Thoroughly fog around shelves, under sinks, refrigeration equipment, dishwashing machines and bottle washers. Treat all returned bottle cartons and cases. Contact as many insects as possible. For badly infested areas, spray daily. During summer months, spraying twice a week is advisable.

CONTACT SPRAY - To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Dilute one part AQUA-FOG with one part water. Spray infested areas such as pet resting places and areas of floor and floor coverings (such as carpet) where these pests may be present. Use at the rate of one gallon of diluted product per 750 square feet of area to be treated. Old pet bedding should be discarded and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment. Do not apply directly to pet. Repeat as needed.

CONTACT SPRAY - To Control Exposed Stages of Certain Insects Infesting Stored Food Products: This would be the Rice Weevil, Granary Weevil, Angoumois Grain Moth, Confused Flour Beetle, Saw Toothed Grain Beetle, Mediterranean Flour Moth and the Indian Meal Moth: Clean areas to be sprayed, especially cracks, crevices, and around machinery. To spray food storage areas, remove food products from shelves and racks.

Spray these areas thoroughly with AQUA-FOG and replace food products. For packaged food, spray in such a manner that light mist will fall on the packages. For food products in bins, paying particular attention to all cracks, crevices, walls and any other places that might offer shelter to the insects. Contact as many insects as possible. After all the local areas of storage have been sprayed, close all windows and doors. Mist the entire storage area, being extremely careful that all open food products are covered. After 10 to 20 minutes, sweep up and destroy all fallen insects. Repeat sprayings at least once a week or when reinfestation becomes evident. Do not treat stored grain products.

Treat Unloading, Handling and Processing Areas: Spray the conveying, processing and handling equipment such as the inside of reel conveyers, sifters, hoppers and proofers, as well as around the base of heavy machinery and equipment. After 10 to 20 minutes remove dead insects and run equipment to aerate before beginning operations.

Hazards to Humans

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Do not apply directly to food. Cover or remove all food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply space sprays and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply space sprays while food processing is underway. After spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries and other food processing plants, wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled.

Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic animals. Do not apply directly to lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Your Amended Application Dated October 26, 1982

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. The label must specify exactly where this is being used. For example, the label should state something like:

For use in food processing plants, food handling establishments, bakeries, restaurants and homes.

- b. The precautionary statement should be revised to read something like the following:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply directly to food. In commercial food handling facilities, cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way.

After space spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries, and other food processing plants, wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.


Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
