WARNING:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

IF SWALLOWED: Get a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Bring promptly a large quantity of milk or diluted vegetable oil to the physician or to the hospital. Do not force quantities of water. Do not induce.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, administer artificial respiration if needed.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE AS A DISINFECTANT

For health and medical facilities, SANA-PHENE should be diluted with water. It is readily soluble even in hard water.

To disinfect food plant floors and walls, interiors of hospital buildings, kitchen tables, drainboards, glass, soda fountains, refrigerators, cooling rooms, lavatories and garbage cans, rinse thoroughly with a solution of 2 1/4 ounces of SANA-PHENE to each gallon of water. Rinse all food contact surfaces with potable water before reuse. Not effective against *Ps. aeruginosa*.

To disinfect floors, cellars, toilet rooms, urinals, and sinks, clean thoroughly; use 2 1/2 ounces of SANA-PHENE to every gallon of water; mop in regular manner. If is impractical to mop specific places, use 4 ounces per gallon of water and spray thoroughly over entire surface.

For more drastic conditions, thorough cleaning must be done by the use of some cleaning solution, removing all dirt and grease. Then disinfect with SANA-PHENE, and wash all contaminated surfaces with clean water. For more information, consult the product label.

GENERAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING:

For general cleaning and disinfecting, use 2 1/2 ounces of SANA-PHENE

to each gallon of water. (Place SANA-PHENE in pail before adding water.) This mixture acts as a disinfectant against *S. typhosa*. It is highly toxic to many gram-negative bacteria. Not effective against *Ps. aeruginosa*. SANA-PHENE has a pleasing aroma and is recommended for public places where discriminating people congregate.

When SANA-PHENE is diluted 1.5 ounces to 1 gallon of water it may be used as a fungicidal agent to scrub swimming pool surfaces commonly contacted by the bare feet, thereby aiding in preventing the transmission of athlete's foot fungi by way of environmental surfaces.
