

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove the victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush the eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not expose to heat or store at temperatures above 130°F/54°C. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.


CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Replace the cap and securely wrap the original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING:
