

SANITIZING: For stainless steel surfaces of tanks, tables and pipelines of food processing plants.

SPRAY OR FOGGING – WHERE CODE PERMITS: Use 1 ounce #1430 ACID SANITIZER to every 4 gallons of water. Sanitizer should have minimal contact time of 5 minutes. Allow equipment to drain before use.

IMMERSION OR FLOWING: Add 1 ounce National's #1430 ACID SANITIZER to every 4 gallons of water used. Allow a minimal contact time of 2 minutes. Allow equipment to drain before use.

NOTE: Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

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DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Corrosive. Causes severe eye damage and skin irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield when handling. If swallowed, avoid food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Do not breathe vapors. Do not wash contaminated clothing until after decontamination.

If swallowed, drink a large quantity of milk, water or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: In case of mucosal damage may require use of gastric lavage. May cause circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion.
