DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Remove all gross food particles and soil by a pre-flush, or pre-scrape and, when necessary, pre-soak treatment. In addition, require thorough washing of surfaces or objects with detergent or compatible cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse before application of sanitizing solution.

SANITIZING: For stainless steel surfaces of tanks, tables and pipelines of food processing plants.

SPRAY OR FOGGING- WHERE CODE PERMITS: Use 1 ounce #1430 ACID SANITIZER to every 4 gallons of water. Sanitizer should have minimal contact time of 5 minutes. Allow equipment to drain before use.

IMMERSION OR FLOWING: Add 1 ounce of #1430 ACID SANITIZER to every 4 gallons of water used. Allow a minimal contact time of 5 minutes. Allow equipment to drain before use.

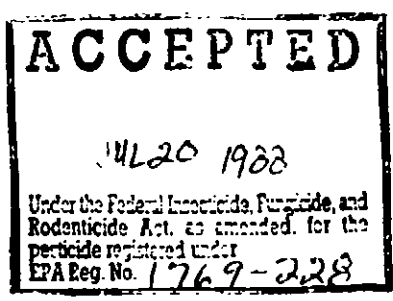
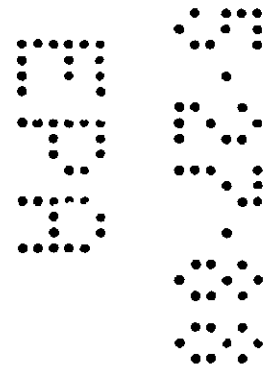

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Plastic Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of the smoke.

Metal Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
