Effective against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Influenza A and Herpes Simplex Type 1 viruses carried on inanimate environmental surfaces.

**Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals**

**DANGER**

Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIANS:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing manually or mechanically may be needed. **GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**DISINFECTION:** Use at 2 ounces per gallon. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* FRD-10 at this level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level, the product is also fungicidal against the pathogenic fungi, trichophyton mentagrophytes. Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits from surfaces prior to application of the recommended solution. To disinfect inanimate environmental surfaces (such as walls, resilient floors, sealed wooden floors, countertops, table tops), add 2 ounces of GRENADIER per gallon of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth or sponge. Rinse with potable water and let air dry.
