HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

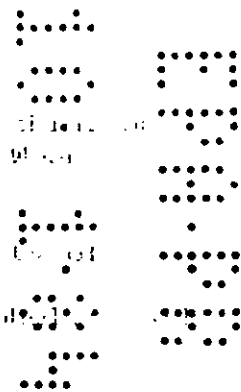
DANGER:

Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Corrosive. Causes eye and skin damage. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, etc. If these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol or phosporum.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARD: Do not use near heat or open flames.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:



IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: KEEP CONTAINER CLOSED.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE AS A DISINFECTANT

For most economical results, SANIT-FINE should be diluted with water. It is readily soluble even in hard water.

To disinfect food plant floors and walls, interiors of hotel buildings, school buildings, play areas, nurseries, lawns, and garbage cans, mix the solution with a solution of 2.142 ounces SANIT-FINE to each gallon of water. Do not use on any surface that may contact food. But effective against E. coli, typhoid.

To disinfect floors, ceilings, toilet rooms, urinals, and tubs, clean the surface with 2.142 ounces of SANIT-FINE to every gallon of water mixed in equal manner. It is impractical to spray specific places and surfaces per gallon of water and spray thoroughly over entire surface.

For more drastic conditions, thorough cleaning must be done by use of strong cleaning solutions, removing all dirt; then, making sure disinfectant comes in contact with all contaminated areas. Disinfect with a solution of 5 ounces of disinfectant per gallon of water.

GENERAL PREMISE CLEANING AND DISINFECTING:

Cleanse floors, walls, glass, toilet rooms, sinks and similar hard surfaces and use a solution of 1.5 ounces of SAN-5-FINE to each gallon of water. (Place SAN-5-FINE in pail before adding water.) This mixture acts as a disinfectant against *S. typhosa*. It is highly toxic to gram-negative bacteria. Not effective against *Ps. aeruginosa*.

SAN-5-FINE has a pleasant piney aroma.
