The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. Revise the statement "Kills HIV I (AIDS VIRUS) ON PRE CLEANED ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS..." to read as outlined below and place this new statement immediately above "Special Instructions for Cleaning...."

*KILLS HIV ON PRE-CLEANED ENVIRONMENTAL SURFACES/OBJECTS PREVIOUSLY SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS in health care settings or other settings in which there is an expected likelihood of soiling of inanimate surfaces/objects with blood or body fluids, and in which the surfaces/objects likely to be soiled with blood or body fluids can be associated with the potential for transmission of human immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) (associated with AIDS).

- b. Under "Directions For Use", include the wording "Disinfects" and instructions to read:

*DISINFECTS-To disinfect hard, nonporous, inanimate surfaces, spray until thoroughly wet, and allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and wipe off surface foam.


- c. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. The product cleaning instructions must be clearly separated from the "directions For Use."
 - d. On the right panel where the product recommended claims are listed as "*CLEANS, *SANITIZES, *DEODORIZES, and *EFFECTIVE AGAINST ..." delete the asterisks so that the wordings read "CLEANS, DISINFECTS SANITIZES, DEODORIZES, VIRUCIDE *, EFFECTIVE AGAINST... Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Pseudomonas aeruginosa..."
 - e. On the Center panel, place the signal word "CAUTION" immediately below the Child Hazard Warning statement.
 - f. Revise the referral statement to read: "See side panel for additional precautionary statement."
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

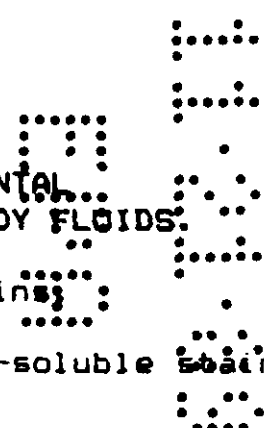

SHAKE WELL

To clean soiled surfaces, spray on and wipe or rinse off. To sanitize non-food contact surfaces after cleaning, lightly spray on FLASH and wipe off surface foam. For cleaning carpets, spray over spotted or stained area, gently work in with a soft brush and absorb with paper tissue or towel.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DECONTAMINATION AGAINST HIV I (AIDS VIRUS) OF HARD, NON-POROUS SURFACES/OBJECTS SOILED WITH BLOOD/BODY FLUIDS.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Before beginning to disinfect contaminated surfaces, the person performing the job should wear disposable latex gloves/gown and a surgical mask..

CLEANING PROCEDURES: Blood and other body fluids must be thoroughly cleaned from surfaces and objects before application of FLASH.

DISPOSAL OF INFECTIOUS MATERIAL: Blood and other body fluids should be autoclaved and disposed of according to federal, state and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.

CONTACT TIME: To disinfect the surfaces/objects, spray FLASH on surface and allow a contact time of 10 minutes at room temperature (20°-25°C) (70°-75°F).

Always test fabric for color fastness in an inconspicuous spot before using product.

NOTE: To prevent clogging due to any buildup of concentrate, wash the aerosol nozzle after each use.

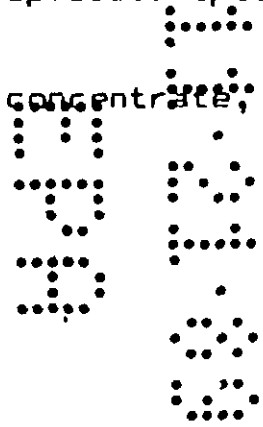

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION Do not breathe spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
