DISINFECTION: Remove grease and dirt from surfaces before disinfecting. Apply 2 ounces per gallon of water to all hard surfaces. Allow to remain on surface for 10 minutes before rinsing.

Sanitization: Apply 1 ounce per gallon of water to all hard surfaces. Allow to remain on surface for 5 minutes before rinsing.

Mold and Mildew: Apply 2 ounces per gallon of water to all hard surfaces. Allow to remain on surface for 10 minutes before rinsing.

Precautions: Do not use on painted surfaces. Do not use on electrical equipment.

MILDEWSTAT: To control mold and mildew follow directions above for disinfecting. Repeat application weekly or when mold and mildew growth reappears.

SANITIZATION: Sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed food processing, meat packing and dairy equipment (such as tanks, blenders, mixers, etc.) with a solution of 2 ounces EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner to 10 gallons of water (200 ppm available chlorine) apply with a cloth or sponge. Make sure the entire surface is completely wet for a least 60 seconds. Let air dry.

To sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed mobile home (such as washing areas and eating utensil areas) completely in a solution of 2 ounces EVERBRITE Germicidal Cleaner to 10 gallons of water (200 ppm available chlorine). Remove and let air dry. Wash dishes and utensils more frequently as well as usual.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals DANGER

Avoid eye contact. Severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes. If in eyes, flush with water. Wash clothes or face cloth and other pieces when handling. Wash hands if contacted.

Skin: Avoid contact with skin. If contact does occur, wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing. If washing clothes, use hot water.

Eyes: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. See a physician.

Ingestion: If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or those are not available, drink 2 cups of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Possible mucous damage may contribute to the onset of pulmonary disease. Measures against circulatory shock, such as oxygen and measures to support breathing, may be indicated. Persistent, convulsant convulsions may require intravenous injection of diazepam.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store in water. Do not feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticides that cannot be used or stored should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticide disposal.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose in an approved pesticide container, or by other approved means.
