The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments.

1. Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula filled out according to the enclosed guide.
2. Add the statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling." below the Directions for Use heading in column 2.
3. Move the "Keep Out of Reach of Children" statement above the signal word.
4. Replace the First Aid heading and associated text with the following.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area of the skin with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash contaminated clothing separately from other laundry.

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

6. Delete the Residual Spray heading and associated text in column 2.

7. Replace the statement "In hospital's patients should be removed prior to treatment." with "If hospital, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Remove patients from room 15-30 hours after spraying. Do not reenter until room aired after ventilation."

8. Replace the statement "Do not use this product in the vicinity of children or disposal of equipment" with "Do not use this product in the vicinity of children or disposal of equipment with care."

9. Delete the statement for the use of this product in the home.

10. Delete the statement for the use of this product in the office.

11. Delete the statement for the use of this product in the school.

12. Delete the statement for the use of this product in the hospital.

13. Delete the statement for the use of this product in the restaurant.

14. Delete the statement for the use of this product in the hotel.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

APPLICATION:

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONTACT AND RESIDUAL SPRAYS

FOR INDOOR USE: In nonfood areas of food handling establishments, commercial, industrial, office, residential, public, institutional and storage buildings, hotels, ship cabins and hospitals: In hospitals patients should be removed prior to treatment. Also for use in buses, automobiles, and nonfood areas of trucks, boxcars and ship cargo holds. Do not use on electrical equipment or on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water. Also for use indoors in dog kennels and horse stables.

In horse stables, not for application if horses will be used for food.

CONTACT SPRAY--KILLS AND REDUCES INFESTATION: COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, ANTS: Apply as a contact spray. Fill spray tank with SYN-TEC 35. Keep spray nozzle about 8 to 12 inches from surface to be treated. Adjust pressure and nozzle to deliver a coarse, wet spray. When possible, spray directly on pests to reduce infestations. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators and other appliances, baseboards and storage areas. Apply spray until area is moist, but not to the point of run-off. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: To kill ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry within buildings and homes. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS: Aids in the control of fleas on pet bedding and in horse stalls. Hold spray nozzle about 18 inches from areas to be treated. Direct spray on resting areas and floor around these areas. Apply spray until area is moist. Treat pet bedding the same way. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. Do not allow pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. Remove or cover animal feed before spraying. Also, treat dogs, cats and horses with a registered flea control product before they re-enter the treated area.

COLUMN 3

RESIDUAL SPRAY: Aids in the control of: COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, ANTS. Kills for up to 4 weeks. Spray baseboards, cracks and crevices around door and window frames, and other hiding places such as closets, in back of and under appliances, sinks and cupboards in kitchens and bathrooms. In basements, spray hiding places in cracks and crevices, lower walls and dark places. Apply as a coarse wet spray in a 4- to 6-inch band until area is thoroughly set, but not to the point of run-off. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Wash after handling. Avoid breathing vapor. Do not spray on humans or pets. Do not spray where food or drink is exposed or being consumed.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do

not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. When used on ships do not wash or flush freshly sprayed surfaces into adjacent waters.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, induce vomiting by sticking finger in back of throat or by administration of syrup of Ipecac; get medical attention. If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes and see a physician. For skin, wash with plenty of soap and water. If irritation develops, get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: GENERAL CLASSIFICATION: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store at temperatures above 32 F./0 C. Do not reuse empty container except for refilling with SYN-TES 35. Otherwise, wrap container and put in trash collection.

Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. (Remove exposed foods.) Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces.
