Subject: Labeling and Confidential Statement of Formula
 Dated December 7, 1978
 EPA Registration No. 1769-292

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments.

1. Delete "and residual."
2. Update the ingredients and Environmental Hazards statements per the Resmethrin Registration Standard.
3. Change the statement:

Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. (Remove exposed food.) Avoid contamination of cooking utensils and food preparation surfaces.

by modifying "Commercially prepared or processed" to "prepared or processed" and move the statement below "In horse stables, not for application"

The Confidential Statement of Formula dated December 7, 1980 is acceptable and has been placed in your product's file.

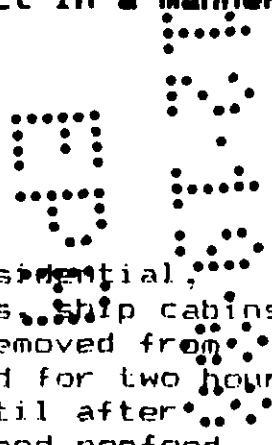
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APPLICATION:

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONTACT AND RESIDUAL SPRAYS

FOR INDOOR USE: In nonfood areas of food handling establishments, commercial, industrial, office, residential, public, institutional and storage buildings, hotels, ship cabins and hospitals: In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation. Also for use in buses, automobiles, and nonfood



areas of trucks, boxcars and ship cargo holds. Do not use on electrical equipment or on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water. Also for use indoors in dog kennels and horse stables. In horse stables, not for application if horses will be used for food.

CONTACT SPRAY--KILLS AND REDUCES INFESTATION: COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, ANTS: Apply as a contact spray. Fill spray tank with SYN-TEC 35. Keep spray nozzle about 8 to 12 inches from surface to be treated. Adjust pressure and nozzle to deliver a coarse, wet spray. When possible, spray directly on pests to reduce infestations. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators and other appliances, baseboards and storage areas. Apply spray until area is moist, but not to the point of run-off. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: To kill ants: Spray trails, nests and points of entry within buildings and homes. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS: Aids in the control of fleas on pet bedding and in horse stalls. Hold spray nozzle about 18 inches from areas to be treated. Direct spray on resting areas and floor around these areas. Apply spray until area is moist. Treat pet bedding the same way. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. Do not allow pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. Remove or cover animal feed before spraying. Also, treat dogs, cats and horses with a registered flea control product before they re-enter the treated area.

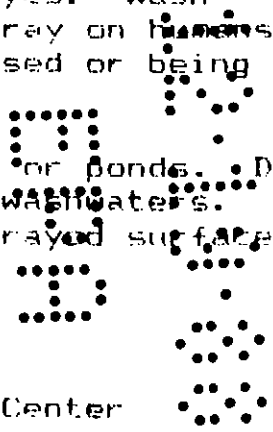
**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC
ANIMALS**

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Wash after handling. Avoid breathing vapor. Do not spray on humans or pets. Do not spray where food or drink is exposed or being consumed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area of the skin with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash contaminated clothing separately from other laundry.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and away from heat or open flame at a temperature above 32 degrees F/0 degrees C.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
