PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapor. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wear mask or respirator of type recommended by NIOSH (National Institute for Occupational Safety or Health) to give adequate protection against this material. Wear protective clothing. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Remove horses before spraying stables.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

IF INHALED: Remove to fresh air.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area of the skin with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wash contaminated clothing separately from other laundry.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Extinguish open flame before space spraying. This formulation is combustible. **DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL, OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.** Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area inaccessible to children and away from heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

GENERAL: Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternate procedures.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DILUTION INSTRUCTIONS: Dilute 6 ounces of SYN TEC-2 with 1 quart (32 ounces) of water (23 ounces of SYN TEC-2 to 1 gallon of water). Mix well before using.

APPLICATIONS

FOR INDOOR USE: In non-food areas of food handling establishments, commercial, industrial, office, residential, public, institutional and storage buildings, homes, hotels, ship cabins and hospitals. In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

Also for use in buses, automobiles, and non-food areas of trucks, boxcars and ship cargo holds. Also for use indoors in dog kennels and horse stables. In horse stables, not for application if horses will be used for food.

DO NOT USE IN COMMERCIAL FOOD HANDLING OR STORAGE AREAS.

COLUMN 3

CONTACT SPRAY--KILLS AND REDUCES INFESTATIONS: COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, ANTS: Apply as a contact spray. Fill spray tank with SYN TEC-2 as diluted above. Keep spray nozzle about 8 to 12 inches (20 to 30 cm) from surface to be treated. Adjust pressure and nozzle to deliver a coarse, wet spray. When possible, spray directly on pests to reduce infestations. Spray thoroughly to hiding places such as cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes and sinks, baseboards, and storage areas. Apply spray until area is moist, but not to the point of runoff. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: To kill ants, spray trails, nests and points of entry within buildings and homes. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLEAS: Aids in the control of fleas on pet bedding and in horse stalls. Hold spray nozzle about 18 inches from area to be treated. Direct spray on resting areas and floor around these areas. Apply spray until area is moist. Treat pet bedding the same way. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat if necessary. Do not allow pets to contact treated areas until spray has dried. Remove or cover animal feed before spraying. Also, treat dogs, cats and horses with a registered flea control product before they re-enter the treated area.
