RIGHT PANEL

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this
product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Close all
doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a
slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room (1,000 cu.
ft.) Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room
thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.
Before spraying remove exposed food and cover utensils.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as
possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts
of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention
should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves
and refrigerators. For control of ants, treat doors, window sills,
and trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary for control.

When used in food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared, food should be removed before treatment. Food contact surfaces and equipment must be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse after using this product. PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing the spray mist. Provide adequate ventilation of the area being sprayed. Contact with skin, eyes and clothing should be avoided. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of food, utensils and food preparation areas. In hospitals, patients should be removed from room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for two hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

Should poisoning occur, get prompt medical attention.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air.

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If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas of the skin with soap and water. Get medical advice if there is irritation develops. Wash contaminated clothing separately from other laundry.

If In Eye: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. *****

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Conflicts: Under pressure. Conflicts occur over the distribution of food near nest or open flame. If pressure is temperate, conflicts are low. Conflicts burst up. Newer, low, the conflict is low. If pressure is high, conflict is high.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. . . .

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store in a container that is away from heat or open flame.

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To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever the insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beetles, Lesser Grain Borers and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

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
