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NATIONAL CHEMSEARCH VACHLOR asphalt vapor barrier will quickly vaporize after application under the asphalt, acting as a powerful inhibitor of germination and acting directly on growing points and root tips, stopping cellular division and elongation. VACHLOR will kill a wide range of shallow and deep rooted annual and perennial weeds. It will not control woody growth such as small trees, brush and woody vines. VACHLOR is not translocated to ornamental trees and shrubs.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Prior to application:

1. Remove all small trees, brush and woody vines from the area to be treated.
2. Plug any holes or cracks that exist in the asphalt.

The minimum gallon of VACHLOR mixture (roughly 1/2 gallon of water for each 1,000 square feet) is required. Stir the VACHLOR well before using, and keep the mixture stirred throughout with water.

Apply the VACHLOR mixture with the spray primer or the sprayer of your choice. Apply the mixture in a uniform layer, covering the asphalt surface with a solution of the mixture. After application, use a roller or equipment to help the mixture penetrate into the asphalt. Do not use the mixture on any surface other than asphalt.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
