DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Prior to application:

1. Remove all small trees, brush and woody vines from the area to be treated.
2. Prepare area for asphalt in the usual manner.

Then mix one gallon of VACHLOR thoroughly with 2-3 gallons of water for each 1,000 square feet to be covered. Stir the VACHLOR well before mixing and keep the mixture agitated after dilution with water.

Do not mix VACHLOR with the asphalt primer or the asphalt. The VACHLOR solution should be applied just prior to laying the asphalt or seal with a suitable oil base primer after application. Hand sprayers may be used to cover areas which cannot be covered with calibrated equipment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
