DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law
to use this product in a manner
inconsistent with its labeling.

To each 250 gallons of water in
the tower and system, add one
gallon CHEM-AQUA 450. Compare
the color with the color in the
comparator kit. Periodically add
more CHEM-AQUA 450 to replace
that which is lost through bleed-
off. Always compare the color
with the standard in the compar-
ator kit to be sure the right con-
centration is present. To pre-
vent line stoppage by excessive
amounts of algae and other debris
be sure that the strainers on the
intake side of the pumps are in
good repair. If excessive
amounts of dead algae scale and
debris are present, the tower
should be drained and the slats
and sump thoroughly cleaned.
When it is refilled, the CHEM-
AQUA 450 should be added to pre-
vent algae growth and corrosion.

Product Name: Chem-Aqua 450

The following changes and/or revisions must be incorporated on the finished printed label which will be used in channels of trade for this product:

- a. The pentachlorophenol used in this product is only 86% active. Therefore, the label declaration should read as follows:

ACTIVE INGREDIENT

Sodium pentachlorophenol4.0%

INERT INGREDIENTS95.4%

A revised Confidential Statement of Formula reflecting the same 8910 lb. batch represented by the manufacturing formula should be submitted.

- b. The signal word "WARNING" and the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" must be 18 and 12 pt type size respectively.
- c. The Storage and Disposal section must contain the following instructions for container disposal.

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local procedures.

- d. The registration number must be indicated on the label as EPA Registration No. 1769-325.
