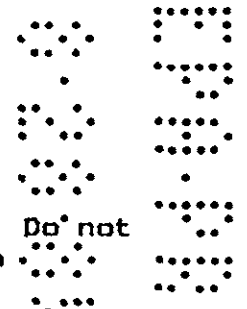

For use on lawns, around buildings, fields, wasteland, golf courses, recreational areas and campgrounds.

For control of an individual fire ant mound measuring 2-9 inches (5-25 cm) high and 5-21 inches (12-60 cm) in diameter, mix 1.5  
tablespoon (14.6 ml) of FIRE ONE in 2 gallons of water (7.57 L) and thoroughly agitate until completely mixed.

Apply this mixture to the undisturbed mound by first using some on the dome to soften the crust. Then use some to soak the perimeter. The remainder should be poured from a height of about 3 feet (1 m) so as to break into the dome and allow the mixture to flow into the underground ant tunnels. Repeat in 7-10 days or as necessary.

For larger mounds, apply greater volumes of diluted material.
