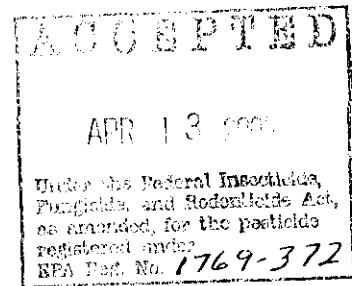

DO NOT REMOVE UNIT DOSAGES FROM CONTAINER UNTIL READY TO APPLY.

Do not use in food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

Nonfood/non-feed areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

DO NOT APPLY WHERE INDIVIDUALS (ESPECIALLY CHILDREN) AND/OR PETS ARE LIKELY TO COME IN CONTACT WITH THE PESTICIDE OR RESIDUE.

For use in and around institutions, hospitals, office buildings, hotels, motels, theaters, schools, warehouses, truck trailers, barns, industrial facilities and railroad cars.

For use with the WASP BLASTER (sold separately). Follow all operation instructions provided by the application equipment manufacturer at the time of purchase. Unit dose will be applied at the proper application rate.

TO CONTROL BEES, WASPS, HORNETS AND YELLOW JACKETS

Stand at a safe distance from the nest to be treated. To prevent dying insects, nest or pesticide from falling on skin and clothing, do not stand directly under the nest being treated. Apply at periods of low activity, typically early morning or evening.

Insert unit doses into WASP BLASTER. While standing up to 30 feet from the nest being treated, with the wind at your back, apply unit dosage (up to 3 capsules, depending on the size of the nest). Check the nest one week after treatment. If there is no insect activity, remove the nest. One application is sufficient for most nests, however if insect activity continues, a second application may be necessary.

For use in inaccessible areas such as attic crawl spaces, wall voids, warehouse bins, etc., insert unit dosages into WASP BLASTER. Apply unit dosage to the nest (up to 3 capsules per nest, depending on the size of nests). The total number of capsules depends on the size of the area being treated. Repeat treatment in one week if insect activity continues.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original sealed container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Keep away from moisture.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide that can not be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty containers. Discard container in trash.
