OUTDOOR TREATMENTS

MOSQUITOES, FLIES, AND GNATS: Dilute to 0.050% or 0.125% when applying as a GENERAL SURFACE SPRAY. To control these pests in open areas near homes and buildings, treat shrubbery, vegetation, and others areas where these pests may rest. Structural surfaces, shrubbery, and vegetation around stagnant pools, marshy areas; ponds, and shorelines may be treated. Treatment of vegetation in water from land is also permitted by allowing wind to move product into vegetation, but application of 'vis product directly to any body of water is prohibited.

AUTOMATED MISTING SYSTEMS: Dilute to 0.050% or 0.125% when applying with automated misting equipment. Automatic spraying systems must not be programmed to release pesticide where people, pets, food, or feed is directly exposed. A legible copy of the label must be securely attached to the equipment pesticide holding container or on the outside of the equipment timer.
