**SANITIZATION OF DAIRY EQUIPMENT:** Clean and rinse thoroughly. Then immerse in a sanitizing solution containing one ounce LO-BAC-10 SANITIZER per four gallons of water. Rinse with potable water after treatment. Milk cans and other equipment should be air dried. This solution is effective in water containing 500 ppm hardness.

**SANITIZATION OF EQUIPMENT IN FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS INCLUDING MEAT PLANTS:** Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly. Then scrub with a solution of one ounce of LO-BAC-10 SANITIZER per four gallons of water. Flush equipment with a clean water rinse before reuse. On surfaces difficult to clean completely (such as meat cutting boards) increase strength of sanitizing solution to one ounce to one gallon of water. Flush surfaces with a clean water rinse before re-use.

**DISINFECTION AND SANITIZATION OF FABRICS:** After washing, agitate in a solution containing one ounce LO-BAC-10 SANITIZER per 64 oz. of water to disinfect clothing and linens. To render diapers and other linens bacteriostatic and to retard development of ammonia immerse in solution containing one ounce LO-BAC-10 SANITIZER for each ten pounds of cloth.

**RESTROOMS:** LO-BAC-10 SANITIZER is a very effective deodorizer and sanitizer for restrooms. Pour one ounce directly into bowls and wash with a brush or swab.

**DANGER-Corrosive KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Rinse empty container with water and discard.

**FIRST AID** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink PROMPTLY a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. If persistent, convulsions may be controlled by the cautious use of a short-acting barbiturate drug.
