

DISINFECTION DIRECTIONS

DANGER-Corrosive **KEEP OUT OF REACH

Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes or on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling concentrate. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink PROMPTLY a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. If persistent convulsions may be controlled by the cautious injection of a short-acting barbiturate drug.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL Prohibitions - Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL Pesticide spray mixture or residue that cannot be used or reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL Triple rinse or equivalent and dispose in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers or bury in a safe place.

GENERAL Consult federal, state or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.
